The Porter Ranch Neighborhood Council (“PRNC”) is an officially-recognized Neighborhood Council by the City of Los Angeles and part of the Los Angeles Citywide system of Neighborhood Councils, working to improve community representation and participation in our City’s government.

The PRNC is open to individuals who live, work or own real property in the neighborhood and also to those who declare a stake in the neighborhood as a community interest stakeholder, defined as a person who affirms a substantial and ongoing participation within the Neighborhood Council’s boundaries and who may be in a community organization such as, but not limited to, educational, non-profit and/or religious organizations.

Members of the *PRNC* are referred to as “Stakeholders.” (Bylaws, Article IV)

The boundaries of the PRNC include those areas within the following lines of demarcation:

The 118 Freeway to the south, the east side of Browns Canyon Road from the City Line to the gate at the south of Brown’s Canyon, then in a straight line to the 118 Freeway on the west, the city line to the north and Aliso Canyon to the east.

The PRNC is governed by a 11-member Governing Board as described in the attached Governing Board table. Board members serve a 4-year term.

Stakeholders interested in being appointed to existing vacancies in the Board are required to fill out and submit the following application form
